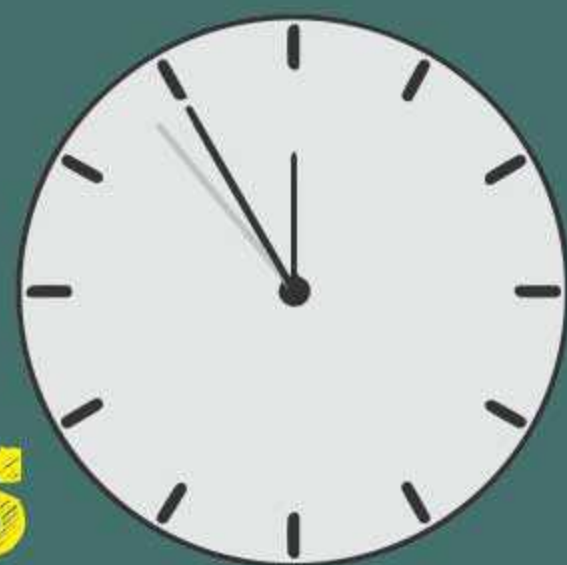

- the '90s



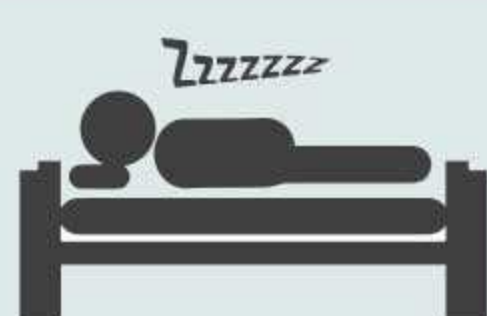
on

- night (All of the night)
- 10:30
- noon / midday
- bedtime
- sunrise / sunset
- the weekend (UK)



since

married since 1980

for

OVER A CERTAIN PERIOD OF TIME (PAST TILL NOW)



in love for 2 years

ago

A CERTAIN TIME IN THE PAST



bought 2 years ago

before

EARLIER THAN A CERTAIN POINT OF TIME



before she gave birth

to

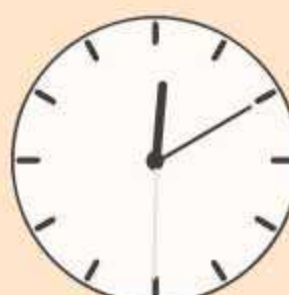
TELLING THE TIME



ten to twelve (11:50)
